

THE HIGH COURT OF SINGAPORE RECOGNIZED AND GRANTED LEAVE TO ENFORCE NCAC ARBITRATION AWARD

In August 2020, the High Court of Singapore recognized and granted leave to a Cambodian creditor to enforce an arbitral award of National Commercial Arbitration Centre of Cambodia (“**NCAC**”) concerning a dispute over the sale of goods.

Our Managing Partner, Mrs. Kattika LOR, and our Partner, Mr. Bunnarith AN, along with their Singaporean counterpart, represented the creditor/claimant in the said case before the High Court of Singapore.
